This horse show is approved by and conducted under the rules of the American Miniature Horse Association, Alvarado, TX. All horses must be registered with AMHA. A COPY OF BOTH SIDES OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS OF EACH HORSE ENTERED MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SHOW CHAIRMAN WITH EACH HORSE ENTRY.

Entries that are received without a copy of both sides of the registration papers will be held pending until such papers are submitted.

NOTE>>> Along with your registration papers, please send a copy of your Stallion Testicular Report for any senior stallion entered. This will save time checking in.

All youth and amateur exhibitors **must provide a copy of their current AMHA Youth or Amateur card with their entries** and provide such #'s on the front side of the entry blank. Applications for both these numbers will be available at the Show Office. Please acquaint yourselves with current AMHA rules concerning youth and amateurs.

The Show Manager reserves the right to settle and determine all questions, differences and disputes arising out of or connected with or incident to this Show within the boundaries of AMHA's current show rules, and to cancel or combine classes.

NO LOGOS, NAMES OR OTHER IDENTIFICATION OF PERSON OR FARM WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY EXHIBITOR OR HORSE IN THE SHOW ARENA

ENTRIES CLOSE : JULY 12th

REGULAR ENTRIES CLOSE JULY 12 , 2009. Entries received after the deadline will be charged an extra fee of Euro 8,00 per class per horse in addition to regular class fees and will not mentioned in the catalouge. Post/Late entries will be accepted until 8:00 a.m. August 8 & 9. Additional class entries will be accepted up to four classes before the class you wish to show.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

All horses must have documentation, endorsed by a veterinarian, of an initial series of two intramuscular injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. In addition, a booster injection must be recorded as having been given at least within every 12 months following the 2nd shot of the initial series.

MEASUREMENT OF HORSES

Horses will be measured between the hours of 3:00-8:00p.m., Friday, August 7th. **ALL HORSES MUST BE MEASURED.** A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at measurement. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement. **If you can't measure within the set hours, please fill in the appropriate space on the entry blank as to when you would like to measure. If there is a problem with your time, we'll call you.**

SPECIAL NOTE - ALL EXHIBITORS

All horses, pre-entered & new entries, must be checked in at the office no later than 30 minutes before the show starts. There's so much to do before the show starts, we can't get the show started on time, without this new policy. The show office will be open each show day, one hour before the show starts. You will be able to resume check in as soon as whatever classes are taking place make it possible.

FEES

Late entry: Entries received after the deadline will be charged an extra fee of EUR. 8,-- per class per horse in addition to regular class fees and will not mentioned in the catalogue.

Refunds: Refunds will not be given without a veterinarian's written certificate stating why the horse is unable to show (illness or injury). There will be no refunds on office fees or stalls.

Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Equine influenza All horses must have documentation, endorsed by a veterinarian, of an initial series of two intramuscular injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. In addition, a booster injection must be recorded as having been given at least within every 12 months following the 2nd shot of the initial series.

Senior Stallion : Owners of senior stallions (3 & older) must present a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for cryptorchidism to show management prior to participating in an AMHnaA sanctioned show. Form can be found on the AMHA website.

Exhibition and transport: Owners are responsible for knowing and meeting any health requirements regarding the exhibition of horses and their transport between their home location and the show.

Please check with your local veterinarian.

GENERAL RULES

Entries: All entry forms, copies of both sides of the AMHA registration papers (in name of current owner) for each horse, lease agreements, copy of Veterinary Inspection for Stallions, are to be sent to the show secretary.

Measuring Measuring will take place from 03:00 - 8:00 p.m. on Friday, August the 7th. All horses must be measured. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at measurement. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement.

PA system It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy.

Evaluation AMHA Judges Evaluation Cards are available in the Show Office.

Conduct Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls, or on the show grounds is strictly prohibited.
The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.
